WHAT DOES BANK OF ANGUILLA DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

Why?

Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

What?

The types of personal information we collect, and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

- Social Security number and income
- Account balances and credit history
- Credit card or other debt and wire transfer instructions

How?

All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons BANK OF ANGUILLA chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

What we do

How does THE BANK OF ANGUILLA protect my personal information?

To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.

How does THE BANK OF ANGUILLA collect my personal information?

We collect your personal information, for example, when you

- Open an account or apply for a loan
- Provide account information or make a wire transfer
- Show your driver's license

We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.

Why can't I limit all sharing?

Federal law gives you the right to limit only

- sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes—information about your creditworthiness
- affiliates from using your information to market to you
- sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you

State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing. See below for more on your rights under state law.

What happens when I limit sharing for an account, I hold jointly with someone else?

Your choices will apply to everyone on your account—unless you tell us otherwise.

Definitions

Affiliates

Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.

- *BANK OF ANGUILLA has no affiliates.*

Nonaffiliates

Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.

- *BANK OF ANGUILLA does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market you.*

Joint marketing

A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.

- *BANK OF ANGUILLA doesn't jointly market.*

Other important information

For Mississippi Customers. We will not share personal information from deposit or share relationships with nonaffiliates either for them to market to you or for joint marketing-without your authorization.
